How to Determine Insurance Reimbursement

At this time, Boise ADHD LLC does not accept insurance. Full payment for the testing bill is due to Boise ADHD by the end of the evaluation day, unless prior alternative payment arrangements have been discussed over the phone. A superbill with CPT testing billing codes and formal diagnostic codes will be provided with the evaluation report (approximately one week after evaluation date), so that the client can use these records to pursue insurance reimbursement for services. It is important to note that insurance companies typically reimburse at a lower rate than a provider's established service fees. Boise ADHD being considered an Out of Network provider may also impact the rate at which insurance will reimburse. It is the client's responsibility, prior to the delivery of services, to check with their insurance company to determine if they cover testing services, if there are any diagnostic exclusions to reimbursement, and reimbursement rates including unit limits per billing code.

Another way of thinking about the questions you need answered from your insurance company include: Do they cover cognitive/psychological testing? Do they only cover testing for certain diagnoses? What do they reimburse per unit for each relevant billing code? And do they have any overall limit on how much testing can be completed? (e.g., some insurance companies will not pay for more than 6 total testing hours)

Testing billing codes include:
90791 (always billed for 1 unit)
96130 (always billed for 1 unit)
96131 (will range from 1 to 4 units)
96136 (always billed for 1 unit)
96137 (will range from 1 to 9 units)
